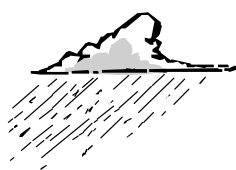

  - *Ed is an international authority on training dogs and handlers to track. He is a leading authority on general health and training issues; Ed is an author, judge and consultant. As a member of the Dog Writers Association of America (DWAA), Ed has been nominated ten times and twice awarded the prestigious Maxwell Award, the Oscar of the Dog World. He has authored numerous short stories, articles and columns for a variety of dog publications*
