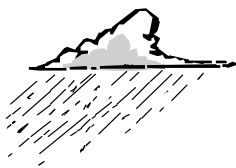
## Our Next Scheduled Meeting

Three fully matted and gated rings will be available for rental. This is not a match – we will be renting the rings only. No club personnel will be available to help with jump set-up or to act as stewards or judges.

We are offering blocks of 30 or 60 minutes in a ring to do whatever you want to do – group practice, individual run-throughs, a class for your students in trial conditions with distractions, or just you playing with your dog.

The ring will be yours for the amount of time you select. 30 minutes @ \$30, 60 minutes @ \$55. Sign up early – you may request specific time periods subject to availability. Bring your friends and share the ring and cost.

Jumps will be available for you to setup as you like within your time block. In other words, you are paying for your setup time. Because we will be on a very tight time schedule you must leave the ring on the hour or half hour so the next person/group can have their full time period. A club member will be present to assure that rings are cleared on time.

Note: If you are late for your scheduled time period you will not be able to make up your lost time, and will not receive a refund for it. It is your responsibility to be ready when your time starts. You must still exit the ring at the posted time.
